Indoor Trial - Argentina 2007

World Championship – Under FIM control

For the third consecutive year, Buenos Aires will be on this year the scenery of a competence belonging to the Indoor Trial World Championship. It will take place on March 10th, into the Luna Park ambience.

Among others, it is confirmed the participation of Adam Raga (actual champion), Albert Cabestany, Toni Bou, Takahisa Fujinami and Doug Lampkin.

Surely it will be again a fantastic spectacle and the entrance tickets, as it happened on the last years, will be sold out several days before.

We prepared a program that will allow you not only to assist to the event but also know some of Argentina through different features for your enjoyment, leaving us the work to prepare everything related to your stay for you to have plenty use of your available time.



Tour Indoor Argentina, basic – 2 nights in Buenos Aires

Buenos Aires is known worldwide as the city where tango was born. Tango surged from Buenos Aires surroundings in the earlier years of the 20th. century.



The Buenos Aires Cabildo, located on the west side of Plaza de Mayo (May Square), is where Argentina was given birth on May 25th, 1810. Therefore, making of it the deepest symbol of Argentinean patriotism.

In what is known as "el bajo" (the lowest place), just beside the antique ravine over which the city grew up, there are numerous buildings in the neighbourhood known as Catalinas Norte.

On the contrary, La Boca neighbourhood, typical because of its origins based on the immigration of Italian people, with its multi-colour constructions, offers an unforgettable vision of another Buenos Aires aspect. The typical restaurants located at this location, known as cantinas, offer menus from the Italian cuisine and the walking areas facilitate the vision and, why not, the acquisition of a craftwork for us to remember our stay in that place.

Saturday 10th March

Arrival to Ezeiza International Airport, reception, transfer and lodging in the selected hotel. Free time for rest.

In the evening, we will go (1) to the Luna Park to view the competition, including your general entrance ticket. At the end we will go back to the hotel.



Sunday 11th March

In the morning we will go for a guided city tour, ending at a restaurant located in Puerto Madero to have lunch. Later we will go back to the hotel.

Approximately at 19:30 hs. we will look for you and assist to a tango show and dinner, with a varied menu and beverages included, at Esquina Carlos Gardel.



Monday 12th March

After having breakfast we will do the rooms check out and, at the appropriate time, the transfer to the airport for your flight back home or continue, after this thrilling weekend, with the stay extend option described below.

Two additional nights in Iguazu.

The Iguazu falls were discovered by Alvar Nuñez Cabeza de Vaca in 1542. During pre-historical time they were inhabited by natives and later occupied by its actual inhabitants, almost all of them coming from Europe, giving its own cultural identity to the Northeast and the Mesopotamia (as the region is known), reflecting on their way of life and their music.

The whole year is suitable to go around this scenery because of its good roads and aerial communications and its excellent lodging infrastructures.

Iguazu means "big water" in the Guarani language. The river flow averages 1.700 m³. per second. When a lot of water comes down, the different cascades merge together forming wide falls. This is why the number of falls, approximately 275 at normal time, can vary a lot.



The most amazing fall of this location is the Garganta del Diablo (Devil' s throat), from which the largest quantity of water falls. The international border between Argentina and Brazil crosses the deepest part of it. The water fall is between 70 and 80 meters high. Approximately 20 kilometres further, the Iguazu river joins the Parana river in the place where Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay borders faces one another. The place is known as Tres Fronteras (Three frontiers).

Monday 12th March

Transfer to Buenos Aires airport and board the flight to Iguazu. Arrival, reception, transfer and lodging at the Esturion Iguazu hotel, 4 stars category. After lunch (not included) we will have a guided tour and view the Brazilian side falls. Dinner in the hotel (beverages not included).

Tuesday 13th March

After breakfast we will have a guided tour and view the Argentinean side falls. Lunch, included in this tour without beverages, will take place into a restaurant inside the Iguazu National Park. Optionally, before lunch and near the end of the falls tour you will be able to go on which is known as "Gran Aventura" (Great Adventure), on board of big rubber boats, completely safe (the upper image shows one of them), with powerful outboard engines, that will first take you beside the places where the water falls from the cascades and after that, navigating several kilometres down the river course where you will go down and cross the jungle into 4WD vehicles. This last part will finish in the same restaurant planned for lunch, where you will join the people that didn' t take this option. Dinner in the hotel (beverages not included).



Wednesday 14th March

After breakfast, transfer to the airport and board a flight to Buenos Aires, continuing to the Ezeiza International Airport for your flight back home.
