#### COPPINS AND CAIROLI BEGUN THEIR TITLE HUNT

VALKENSWAARD, 01 April 2007- The season opener of the FIM Motocross We Championship got underway today, on the **Eurocircuit at Valkenswaard**, in front of **25 spectators**. It was a breathtaking day for the fans, who witnessed a great Josh Coppins win MX1 Grand Prix of Benelux, and an incredibly fast Antonio Cairoli dominate the MX2 GP. track conditions were **dry**, and the weather was **sunny**.

## <u>MX1</u>

This was the first MX 1 GP without Stefan Everts, who dominated the last six editions of the st and finally arrived to an impressive tally of 10 World Title victories. Yamaha Motocross Coppins showed both speed and consistency, and won the Grand Prix in front of KTM Bull's Jonathan Barragan and Suzuki WMX GP's Steve Ramon.

## MX1 RACE 1

Josh Coppins had a great start, but poleman De Dycker passed him before the end of the ope lap. The Belgian tried to pull away with the lead, but he was caught by the Kiwi at lap se Ramon crashed while he was following the leaders, but he was quickly back on the bike to pas Dycker at lap fifteen, and finally finish second behind winner Coppins. **De Dycker** paced him and finished the race in third place, ahead of countryman Strijbos, who was too far from De Dy to aim at the top three. Barragan was fifth, ahead of a fantastic **Marc De Reuver**, who crash lap one and restarted from twentieth.

## MX1 RACE 2

In a fantastic opening lap, David Philippaerts and Jonathan Barragan were leading the group Coppins and Ramon were battling their hardest for third place. Philippaerts lost the lead in lap then retired for technical problems, as his team mate Barragan lead the group until the cheque flag, showing an impressive rhythm. Coppins settled for second, and his team mate **De Re** completed the top three, after he passed Philippaerts and De Dycker. Strijbos raced a consist moto, to finish fourth after he was eight at the end of the opening lap. Belgian Priem complete top five, as countryman Ramon crashed and finished sixth.

#### MX2

Yamaha De Carli's **Antonio Cairoli dominated the first GP**, as he grasped two back to l wins. KTM Red Bull's **Tyla Rattray** raced two stoic motos, because he was not 100% fit afte crash in yesterday's qualifying heat. The South African was second overall, as countryman **Gamepoel** of Molson Kawasaki clinched his maiden podium.

## MX2 RACE 1

Nicolas Aubin was first at the start, but Avis and Swanepoel moved past him before the end o opening lap. Avis lead the race until lap five, then he was snatched the lead by Swanepoel. Cawas packed in the group after the start, but he found his way to first place thanks to an imprepace. Rattray was coming up from eight, and raced a consistent first heat to finish second be Cairoli. Early leaders Avis and Swanepoel had different fortunes: Avis crashed at lap ten, finished the race in seventeenth place, and Swanepoel finished third behind countryman Rat Gundersen was fourth, and home rider Eggens made it to the top five by passing Aubin in the last lap. Defending Champion **Pourcel** was seventh.

## MX2 RACE 2

Avis lead the first couple of laps, then was passed by Pourcel and Searle. Pourcel was leading Searle, who was passed by Cairoli. But the Frenchman crashed, and handed the first place to Italian rival. Searle was second and Pourcel was right behind him in third, but they both cra after a jump while landing. As **Pourcel** rejoined the race to finish third, **Searle** was out, physically ok. Eggens was fourth, ahead of Gundersen, who raced another solid moto. Swane raced a consistent moto and finished sixth, making it to the overall podium. Once again Ra came up from behind —ninth at the end of lap one- and conquered another well deserved se

place.

In the **MX2 class**, **Antonio Cairoli is first** with 50 points. The Italian is very motivated for thi campaign, but so is Tyla Rattray, second in the standings. Gareth Swanepoel is third, and defer Champion Christophe Pourcel and veteran Erik Eggens complete the top five.
